



Three time Emmy-nominated composer/pianist Steve Sandberg plays original music that blends classical, world music and jazz with the excitement of virtuosic improvisation. He has toured internationally with Bebel Gilberto, Dr. L. Subramaniam, David Byrne, Ruben Blades, Mario Rivera and Tito Puente. He has conducted and arranged on Broadway and for many regional and Off-Broadway theatres, including the New York Shakespeare Festival. Most recently, he was nominated for three Emmy Awards for his work as musical director and composer for Nickelodeon's "Dora the Explorer" and "Go, Diego, Go!" He leads the Steve Sandberg Quartet featuring violinist Zach Brock, which has appeared at Birdland, Symphony Space, Sidedoor Jazz, Miller Symphony Hall and the DiMenna Center. He teaches all levels of piano with an emphasis on classical music and improvising for classically trained pianists.
